Our children's and youth ministries are growing. There are many opportunities for you to become involved in

F.A.I.T.H. will feature a twelve-week course from 6:00 -7:00 written by Ergun Caner (a converted Muslim who is now Dean of the Liberty University Seminary in Virginia). The course is entitled, When Worldviews Collide: Christians Confronting Culture, and is open to everyone. I will be facilitating the course. F.A.I.T.H. trained persons will be leading visitation teams at 7:00 p.m. Our desire is that every Sunday School class be represented in these ministries. Our discipleship courses, Experiencing God, Financial Peace University and Men's Fraternity are well attended and are making a difference in our lives. Thank you to the facilitators and participants of these ministries.
