### Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

We have been considering H.W. Brands' reflections on Abraham Lincoln in his collection of essays entitled, Lincoln's Genius.

In his essay, We Must Not Be Enemies, Dr. Brands wrote (p. 22), "Lincoln had sought the presidency by means that invited confusion. He won the Republican nomination largely on the strength of his House Divided speech of 1858, in which he declared that America could not continue half slave and half free. But in the general election the Republicans promised to leave slavery alone in the states where it existed, and Lincoln embraced that promise without ever overtly disavowing the uncompromising message of the House Divided address."

Have you ever worn a Christian tee shirt and had someone challenge or question your faith? I have. Believe me, that is a reality check for your convictions! If we make the decision to say something with conviction, it is fair to be expected to defend our words with conviction. A similar scenario occurred when Peter vowed that he would lay down his life for Jesus' sake, only to deny Him three times in the next few hours. Of course, by His grace, Jesus restored Peter and Peter later wrote, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear." (1 Pet 3:15). The greatest thing about following Jesus is grace. Jesus is the provider of amazing grace. John wrote in 1 John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." More often than not, it is not God's forgiveness that is needed (it is already provided); it is forgiving ourselves for past mistakes. Satan has a way of clouding our memories of truths like Romans 8:31 and Philippians 4:13 with self doubt that leads to inaction. Our confidence lies not in our abilities but in Christ's unmerited favor.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
