The leadership of the Southern Baptist Convention has called for a Solemn Assembly of prayer, fasting and repentance this Sunday, January 30. According to www.sbc.net, the purpose for this emphasis is as follows:

“The SBC Day of Prayer is a time of prayer, fasting, and repentance. The goal of this Solemn Assembly is for congregations to "Be still and know that God is God," as a sign of humility and desire to wholeheartedly return to Him. By being still before Him (see Psalm 46:10), we exalt our God and position ourselves to obey the Great Commandment found in Mark 12:29-31 and the Great Commission our Lord gave in Matthew 28:18-20. We have forgotten our first love (Revelation 2:4). We need revival in the SBC. We need God's direction.” AMEN!

We will celebrate communion this Sunday followed by a fellowship meal. Although we, as a body, will break the bread of the Lord's Supper together and share a fellowship meal, you may want to choose to fast Saturday through breakfast on Sunday and break your fast with our fellowship meal.
