

#### **Parking**

We must save the spaces directly in front of the church for emergency vehicles. Handicapped parking is available in the rear parking lot. Parking

for workers is available at Summit Drive School. A shuttle will run from 4:00 - 5:15 and after the service for these workers. Parking is also available at the Vietnamese Church at the corner of Summit and Rutherford. Some parking is available on the street, but please be careful not to block driveways of residences. Carpool with someone, if at all possible, and bring one (1) car per family.



## **Book Signing**


