Important, Please Read! Outside Locks Have Been Changed

Locks on all outside entrances have been changed. If you had a key prior to December 12, it will not open the outside doors now. If your old key opened any inside doors, it will continue to do so.

Keys are now given out to committee chairmen for the term that they serve. When the term is completed, that key must be returned to the office for the next chairman.

Keys must not be duplicated or loaned to another person.
