Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ!
Service. The Christian life is a life of service. Service for God and service for others. Service.

We have been studying the great Spiritual Disciplines of the Christian faith on Wednesday nights at Northgate. We have been following Richard Foster's outline found in his book, Celebration of Discipline: The Path to Spiritual Growth. So far, we have looked at the inward disciplines of meditation, prayer, fasting and study and the outward disciplines of simplicity, solitude, submission and service. Soon, we will conclude our study with a look at the corporate disciplines: confession, worship, guidance and celebration.

Personally, I have been challenged by revisiting these disciplines; especially so by the discipline of service. As I was meditating on this discipline, God revealed to me that service is the highest and most dependant of the personal, outward disciplines. It depends upon the practice of meditation, prayer, fasting, study, simplicity, solitude and submission. Without these, there can be no truly obedient service. Jesus set this example; He practiced all of the Spiritual Disciplines before He served and while He was serving. We must first find God and His will through all of these other Spiritual Disciplines in order to humbly obey Him through the Spiritual Discipline of service.

In Mark 10:45, Jesus said, "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Find your place of service; but before that, find yourself in Christ.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church!
