

# Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ!

I want to remind you of the events of Holy Week as we prepare to worship our blessed Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

You will remember that the Sunday before Jesus was crucified for our sins and rose from the dead, He rode triumphantly into the city of Jerusalem upon the back of a lowly donkey (Mark 11). Of course, that **Sunday** is Palm Sunday. We will celebrate Palm Sunday in Sunday School at 9:30, in worship at 10:45, and in a special evening worship service at St. John's Baptist Church at 7:00 p.m. In that service, the choirs of Northgate and St. John's will join together for a tremendous musical offering to our Lord. In this holy service, we will practice the Spiritual Discipline of Silence and participate in a silent Lord's Supper with our brothers and sisters at St. John's. This service will be repeated at Northgate on Maundy Thursday.

On **Monday**, you will remember that Jesus cursed the fig tree and cleansed the temple (Mark 11).

On **Tuesday**, He taught His disciples, challenged the religious leaders, and delivered the great Olivet Discourse, teaching about the future and His glorious Second Coming (Mark 11-14).

Wednesday is traditionally the day of silence in Holy Week.

On Thursday, Jesus and His disciples shared their last supper together (John 13). At that holy event, four significant things happened: He washed His disciple's feet, He instituted the Lord's Supper, He was betrayed by Judas, and He gave a new commandment. Church history traditionally recognizes the Thursday before Easter as Holy Thursday or Maundy Thursday. The word Maundy comes from the Latin word, Mandatum (commandment). *Mandatum* is the first word of this third (new) commandment that Jesus gave (John 13:34). That verse (in Latin) reads: "Mandatum novum do vobis ut diligatis invicem sicut dilexi vos." The English translation is: "A new commandment I give unto you, that you love one another; as I have loved you." We will celebrate Maundy Thursday at 7:00 p.m. with the combined choirs of Northgate and St. John's. We will also observe a silent Lord's Supper in this service. Please understand that this will be a very holy and reverent service. We ask that you enter the sanctuary in total silence, remain silent throughout the service, and continue this silence until you arrive home. At that time, we invite you to continue your worship as you discuss the service and your

experience of it with your family. Please respect the integrity of this Holy Day by practicing the Spiritual Discipline of Silence as we contemplate the events of Holy Week and consider the significance of it all.

On **Friday**, Jesus was crucified for the sins of the world and buried in a borrowed tomb.

**Saturday**, He lay in the grave missed and mourned by those who followed Him.

Early **Sunday** morning, He arose. Hallelujah!!! Glory to the Lamb!!!!
