perseverance. He wrote, "When Ralph Houk was manager of the New York Yankees, baseball schedules were even more exacting than they are now, with double -headers almost every week. Occasionally a player would get sick of the grind and ask Houk for permission to sit out a game. The manager would say, 'I know how you feel, sure, take the day off, but do me a favor. You are in the starting lineup, just play one inning, and then skip the rest of the game.' The player would honor Houk's request – and almost invariably get caught up in the spirit of the game and play it out to the end."

That's a great lesson for us. In Matthew 6:34, Jesus said we are to live one day at a time. Maybe for a baseball player, that's one inning at a time or for a student, one semester at a time. Whatever your situation in life, if you are a Christian, don't give up on Him! Never just allow yourself to be caught up in the culture, compromise your beliefs, and go with the flow. That's the attitude of a quitter. Never quit! Stand tall for Christ one day at a time and at the end of the game, you will be glad you did. "So use every piece of God's armor to resist the enemy whenever he attacks, and when it is all over, you will still be standing up." Eph. 6:13 (The Living Bible).
