BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR DEACON SERVICE

In accordance with the meaning of the Word and the practice of the office, as outlined in the New Testament, Deacons are to be servants of the church. The task of the Deacon is:

- * To serve with the Pastor (and staff) in performing pastoral ministries.
- * To proclaim the Gospel to believers and unbelievers.
- * To care for the welfare of the church body and for others in the community.
- * To lead the church to engage in the fellowship of worship, witness, education, ministry, and application.
- * To support the church in performing its tasks.
- * To make such recommendations to the church as Deacons deem appropriate to fulfill the objectives, goals and policies of the church.

The office of Deacon is a noble and holy calling. The following requirements for serving as a Deacon are:

- * The Deacon must be 21 years old and a member of the church for a year or more, and must fulfill the requirements indicated in the New Testament. (1 Timothy 3:8-15; Acts 6:1-7).
- * Live a consecrated life, bringing no reproach, either by conduct or by attitude, upon the church or the cause of Christ.
- * Regularly attend and participate in the services and activities of the church.
- * Must be willing to work with the Deacon body to resolve any conflicts that may arise in the church body.
- * Be faithful in giving, with the tithe as the minimal objective.
- * Exercise confidentiality.
- * Be evangelistic and missionary in spirit and practice, deeply committed to winning the lost and discipling them in the faith.
