Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ:

What better time do we have to immerse ourselves in the things of Christ than when we are already devoting ourselves to the task of the gospel for the larger part of that week. Philippians 4: 8 reads, "Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you."

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
