- 1. What is making me feel angry?
- 2. Is it possible that I am making assumptions or jumping to conclusions?
- 3. Is the situation making me feel threatened, afraid or inferior?
- 4. Did my anger come as the result of some unrealistic expectation?
- 5. How might others view this situation that is making me angry?
- 6. Are there things I can do to change the situation in order to reduce my anger?

There are also three necessary requirements for controlling our anger. No four. They are:

- 1. Humility
- 2. Confession
- 3. Forgiveness
- 4. Self-Control
