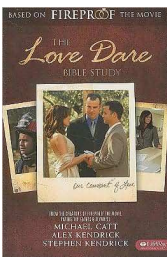
- ➔ There will be a special business meeting for the purpose of discussion and vote on our child screening policy.

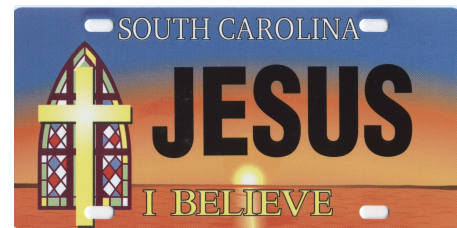


Ladies, remember your [Women on Mission](#) group meetings on Tuesday, June 23 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.
