Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Before you receive your next Gatepost in the mail, a team of students from Northgate will be making their way to Greece. Their purpose in

going is to change Greece through *World Changers*. Please pray for them. Pray for their every need. Pray for their safety. Pray for their walk. Pray for them as they interact with the Greek people. Pray for them as you read The Acts of the Apostles chapters 16 and 17.

They will be visiting some of the most important places in the ancient world as they follow the steps of Paul in reverse order. They will be spending a day in Athens, the largest city in Greece, where Paul delivered his infamous "Mars Hill" discourse in Acts 17:22-34. They will also be visiting the second largest city in Greece, Thessaloniki. In New Testament times, this city was the Roman capital city of one of the four districts of Macedonia. Today, it is the capital city of all of Macedonia. In New Testament times, this city had a large Jewish population. It still does. In New Testament times, Paul preached there during his second and probably his third missionary journeys (Acts 17:1-4; 20:1-3). While in Thessaloniki, our students will make the ninety mile day trip to Philippi where they will have the opportunity to see the traditional site of the prison from which Paul and Silas were miraculously delivered and the stream where Paul traditionally baptized Lydia and the Philippian jailer. Perhaps they will even see the traditional site of the church where Epaphroditus left to make the long journey to Rome to bring aid to Paul. You can read about Paul's work in Philippi in Acts 16:9-40.

Pray for our team as they go to be world changers and pray that they return changed by the biblical world! Pray for our students and leaders as they go to be "fellow workers" with Paul in Greece.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church!


