


Northgate Mission Statement

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ!

I enjoy reading. One of the authors I enjoy is Ambrose Bierce. Bierce was a satirist who lived and wrote mostly in the nineteenth century. A

veteran of the American Civil War, he wrote telling and stinging criticisms about war and its absurdities. His contributions to culture were (even during his lifetime) appreciated and continue to be appreciated to this very day. He was at his best when he was writing about the foolishness of war; however, he also strayed into other cultural venues such as family and faith. He famously wrote in his work, *The Devil's Dictionary*, that human birth was "The first and direst of all disasters."

It is important to note that he wrote *The Devil's Dictionary* in 1911. Granted, a work entitled, The Devil's Dictionary, shouldn't be expected to produce a well spring of wisdom, but Ambrose Bierce was akin to Mark Twain in popularity and literary success. In fact, he was a contemporary of Mark Twain. Well, it seems that this famous line that human birth was "The first and direst of all disasters," was a reflection of the personal pain of his own life (something he shared with Twain). Bierce was married on Christmas Day in 1871. He had three children (two sons and a daughter). Both of his sons died before him - Day was shot to death when he was seventeen over a brawl with a woman and Leigh died of pneumonia related to his alcoholism when he was twenty-seven. Bierce separated from his wife because he suspected unfaithfulness the year before his first son died and finally divorced her three years after the death of his second son. Knowing that he penned this famous line in his most popular and enduring work after these tragedies explains much. Bierce died in Mexico in 1914.

As we reflect upon our lives, what do we see as our successes? Mark Twain, Ambrose Bierce, Benjamin Franklin are only a few of many that have had successful professional lives, but disasters at home. We need to be very careful that we keep the first things first.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
