
# **Northgate Mission Statement**

#### **Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ!**

Acts 1:8 – "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea

and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Our Week of Prayer for Northgate Baptist Church is only ten days away! Soon, you will receive a prayer guide to help you pray for Northgate during this important week. You will also find offering envelopes in the pews and around the church for your convenience in giving to our Vision Offering.

One thing that I had to "pray through" concerning this week of prayer and its accompanying offering was its effect upon missions. But because Northgate is a mission-minded church, God gave me a peace about this. God allowed me to "see" a dollar as it goes through Northgate Baptist Church's offering plate. For every dollar that comes into Northgate through our regular budget offerings, ten cents goes to the Cooperative Program. About six of those ten cents will remain in South Carolina (our Judea) while the other four cents will go to the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention. One cent of the four cents that goes to the Executive Committee will be forwarded to the North American Mission Board (our Samaria) and two cents will be forwarded to the International Mission Board (the end of the earth). The other one cent that goes to the Executive Committee will be divided up to help support our six seminaries and other Southern Baptist entities.

When we do the math we find that if we reach our Victory goal of \$60,000, we are automatically giving \$3,600 to South Carolina State Baptist Missions. If we reach our Challenge goal, we will give \$4,800 to State Baptist Missions, and if we reach our Hallelujah goal, we will be giving \$6,000 to State Baptist Missions. In addition to that, we will also be giving \$600, \$800 or \$1,000 respectively to North American Missions and \$1,200, \$1,600 or \$2,000 respectively to International Missions. Those dollars to North American and International missions are in addition to the designated offerings (Lottie Moon and Annie Armstrong) that we will make later in the church year.

Most importantly, we will be focusing upon Northgate's vision to reach our community (Our Jerusalem) through our local missions and ministries. The local church must remain strong if we are to be effective in reaching our larger mission fields. My desire is that our Week of Prayer will be a life changing experience for Northgate Baptist Church. I am excited about the possibilities! I intend to spend some of that week (August 23-30) fasting as I pray for God's

Spirit of revival to fall on Northgate in the coming weeks. More about fasting next week.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
