Nathan C. Schaeffer posed a good question. At the close of life, the question will not be, "How much have you gotten?" but "How much

have you given?" Not "How much have you won?" but "How much have you done?" Not "How much have you saved?" but "How much have you sacrificed?" It will be "How much have you loved and served," not "How much were you honored?"

We have suffered many deaths in the past two months. It would be wise for us to reflect upon our own lives and spend some time in reflective prayer. Becoming a servant of Christ doesn't come by default. It comes by submission, surrender and willful obedience to Christ's call to take up our cross and follow Him.

Michael Jinkins shares a good story about Clarence Jordan, author of the "Cotton Patch" New Testament translation and founder of the interracial Koinonia farm in Americus, Georgia. He was once getting a red-carpet tour of another minister's church. With pride the minister pointed to the rich, imported pews and luxurious decoration. As they stepped outside, darkness was falling, and a spotlight shone on a huge cross atop the steeple. "That cross alone cost us ten thousand dollars," the minister said with a satisfied smile. "You got cheated," said Jordan. "Times were when Christians could get them for free."

I pray you will make discipleship a priority in your life in 2010.
