Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Why do we observe President's Day? We used to observe Washington's and Lincoln's birthdays on their birthday (what a novel idea?). Washington's birthday is actually February 22 and Lincoln's birthday is actually February 12.

Since 1971, we have combined them into one Federal holiday to be celebrated on the third Monday in February. We have had forty-four presidents of the United States. Why don't we observe the birthdays of all of them? Since the third Monday in February 1971, we do!

Forty-four presidents? Well, not exactly. Technically, President Obama is our Forty-fifth president. David Rice Atchison was, technically, our twelfth president. He served for one day. When James A. Polk's presidency ended on Sunday, March 4, 1849, the country was left without a President. Polk's successor, Zachary Taylor refused to take the oath of office on a Sunday and waited until Monday. Since the Vice President (Millard Filmore) was not sworn in either, that meant that the responsibilities of the President of the United States fell to the next in line to (at that time), President Pro Tempore of the Senate, David Rice Atchison. On Monday, Zachary Taylor was sworn in as President and David Atchison's brief presidency came to an abrupt end.

What lessons can we learn from this footnote in history? Be ready! Always be ready! We never know when life will thrust us into an opportunity or a responsibility that requires more from us. That's why the church offers training. Discipleship Training, Evangelism Training, Sunday School, etc. 2 Timothy 4:2 says, "Preach the word! Be READY in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching." 1 Peter 3:15 says, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be READY to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear."

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
