On February 24, 1582, Pope Gregory XIII introduced the Gregorian calendar. What is the Gregorian calendar? It is the calendar that lets us know that it is February 24, 2010! It is the calendar the world uses today. Have you ever

thought much about time? One thing we know is that Jesus Christ changed it. Before He was born, time was called B.C. and since then, it is called A.D. B.C. stands for "Before Christ." A.D. stands for "Anno Domini." Anno Domini is a Medieval Latin term which literally means, "In the year of our Lord." But you might find it interesting that Anno Domini is an abbreviated version of what A.D. really stands for. The full translation of A.D. is Anno Domini Nostri Jesu Christi. Do you know what date it is in the atheistic regime of North Korea? It is February 24, 2010 A.D. (in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ)! Do you know what the date is in Mecca, Saudi Arabia (the holiest city in Islam)? It is February 24, 2010 A.D.

The unmistakable and undeniable truth is that Jesus Christ changed everything when He came into the world as the incarnation of Almighty God. He changed civilizations; He changed people; He changed the world; He change time. And every time we look at the calendar we are reminded of His sovereignty.

One day every knee in every nation will bow and every tongue of every person will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord! We are all like the candy I used to enjoy as a child, "Now and Laters." Every person that ever lived is either going to bow to Jesus Christ and confess Him as Lord now or we will do it later! One way or the other every one of us will confess the Lordship of the Christ! Why don't you submit your life to Jesus Christ right now. Later may be too late for you!

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
