

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I enjoyed watching the Winter Olympics. I also enjoyed keeping up with the athletes and their stories. One such athlete is U.S. speedskater, Chad Hedrick.

When Chad and his team took the Silver Medal on February 27 in the men's team pursuit competition, he tied Eric Heiden for the most medals ever won by a men's U.S. long track speedskater. According to Baptist Press, Hedrick said, "I am very happy walking away from Vancouver." He continued, "This is my fifth medal, all in different distances. Major accomplishment for me, and the next step in life is going to be a lot of fun."

Hedrick said that he had another mission in Vancouver; a mission to show the world that he is a different person than he was in 2006, when he won three medals in Turin, Italy. Hedrick was once considered to be the Paris Hilton of speedskating for his active nightlife and party reputation. Since Turin, he has married and had a daughter. He has also been born again.

Read the following excerpt about Chad from a February 15, 2010 article in *Black Christian News*:

"You grow up, and when people ask you if you're a Christian, the proper thing to say is, 'Yeah, I'm a Christian," Hedrick said. "But saying you're a Christian and living like a Christian are two completely different things." Hedrick in recent months began noticing how people around him were living, including the quality of the lives of those who professed to be Christians. He was intrigued by what he saw. He began asking questions of those people and investigating Christianity, ultimately choosing to place his faith in Christ and be baptized at Champion Forest Baptist Church in Spring, Texas, in November. His wife Lynsey was baptized with him. "Now I don't just say I'm a Christian," Hedrick said. "Now I live like one."

Living like a Christian is being an on-purpose person. Christ gives us a new purpose in life and that purpose is to be on mission for Him. By the way, when Chad won those five medals in this year's Olympic games, the following was carved into the blades on his skates: CGIM (See God in me). Read 1 Cor. 3:10-16. What kinds of medals or rewards will you lay at the feet of Jesus?

Here is an idea: invite someone to church for Friend Day and again for Easter.
