



What a great time of worship we had last Sunday with our friends! Thank you for inviting your

friends to Northgate! God's church is a community of Christians gathered together for the purposes of worship, discipleship, fellowship, ministry and evangelism. I think we can safely say that we enjoy all of those five purposes of the church at Northgate!

As we approach Holy Week, let us prepare our hearts and minds for worship by committing to read Scripture and devoting time to praying for spiritual renewal during this very special time of the year. If you do not currently have a daily devotion, allow me to suggest to you a way to begin one. Richard Foster wrote a plan many years ago that is a great way to begin a rich daily devotion with the Lord. He entitled it, *Seven Minutes With God*. The following is a brief outline of the plan:

- 1. Devote the first **thirty seconds** to a quick prayer asking God for direction.
- 2. Devote the next **four minutes** to reading the Bible (suggestion: Is. 53; Mark 11-16; John).
- 3. Devote the remaining **two minutes and thirty seconds** to prayer.

Foster suggests the following outline for prayer:

- A Adoration (1 Chronicles 29:11)
- C Confession (1 John 1:9)
- T Thanksgiving (Ephesians 5:20)

Sunday

S – Supplication (Matthew 7:7)

If you follow this pattern, you will soon find it impossible to spend only seven minutes with God and will find yourself worshipping Him for thirty minutes or more! Just remember, don't become devoted to the habit, but to the Savior!

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church!
