Parter According to his website, "H. W. Brands was born in Oregon, went to college in California, sold cutlery across the American West, and earned graduate degrees in mathematics and history in Oregon and Texas. He taught at Vanderbilt University and Texas A&M University before joining the faculty at the University of Texas at Austin, where he is the Dickson Allen Anderson Centennial Professor of History."

In an essay written by Dr. Brands in his collection, "Lincoln's Genius," he wrote (p.11), "Lincoln's friends knew he was prone to depression – 'melancholy,' as the era dubbed it. His law partner William Herndon would watch him enter the office, start work and then drift into aimless distraction, til he could do nothing but stare out the window in a blue funk. 'Gloom and sadness were his predominate state,' Herndon recalled." Brands continued, "Lincoln's state of mind worsened as he reached middle age, aggravated by a nagging fear that life was passing him by. The practice of law left him unfulfilled. His marriage had lost its spark. He tried his hand at politics, and his minor triumphs briefly mitigated his melancholy. But he never found a consistent formula for reaching voters. His two-year stint in Congress, now a decade past, had been undistinguished, unappreciated and unrepeated."

Prior to 1860, it would have been easy and safe to have called Abraham Lincoln a failure – a man who had made a limited (if any) contribution to society. Today, we are reminded of his incredible impact upon the world every time we spend a penny or a five dollar bill. We must be careful not to measure our impact upon the world too soon. We never know what God has for us just around the corner!

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
