Partor reflections on Abraham Lincoln in his collection of essays entitled, Lincoln's Genius.

He wrote on p.11, "Abraham Lincoln would prove to be the greatest president in American history. Yet he wasn't born great, and there was nothing inevitable about his ascent to the American pantheon. He was an ordinary human being who had to base critical decisions on incomplete information, and he could never know until after the fact if he was doing the right thing. When he discovered he wasn't, he altered the course and carried on."

We can relate Lincoln's philosophy of life to Scripture. "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Heb. 11:1). We live lives that matter for Christ not by knowing what the future holds, but by knowing Who holds the future. We too base critical decisions on incomplete information; but we can know that we are doing the right thing. Solomon wrote, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not upon your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths" (Prov. 3:5-6). We live not in a chaotic universe that is absolutely unpredictable and totally without order; but in a universe crafted and controlled by the very Word of God. If God can create and control all that is, then we can trust Him to guide our lives when we abide in His Word.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
