Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

We have been considering H.W. Brands' reflections on Abraham Lincoln in his collection of essays entitled, *Lincoln's Genius*.

Abraham Lincoln and his wife, Mary, had four sons: Robert, Edward, Willie and Tad. The Lincoln's lost one son (Edward) to death in February 1850. They lost a second son (Willie) in February 1862. Tad died at the age of eighteen in July 1871 (after Lincoln's death). Robert, their oldest son, is the only one of their four children to live to adulthood. He died in July 1926. In his essay, *Our Souls Will Not Harden*, Dr. Brands wrote (p. 30), "Willie's death reminded him [Lincoln] how fragile human existence is." Dr. Brands continued (p. 36), "Lincoln's loss of Willie and his solicitousness of Tad made him especially sensitive to the plight of families whose sons had died in the war. His assistants told him that a Boston widow, Lydia Bixby, had lost five sons in the fighting. In November 1864 Lincoln wrote her a letter:"

Dear Madam:

I have been shown in the files of the War Department a statement of the Adjunct General of Massachusetts, that you are the mother of five sons who have died gloriously on the field of battle. I feel how weak and fruitless must be any words of mine which should attempt to beguile you from the grief of a loss so overwhelming. But I cannot refrain from tendering to you the consolation that may be found in the thanks of the Republic they died to save. I pray that our Heavenly Father may assuage the anguish of your bereavement, and leave you only the cherished memory of the loved and lost, and the solemn pride that must be yours, to have laid so costly a sacrifice upon the altar of Freedom.

Yours, very sincerely and respectfully,

A. Lincoln

Although further investigation would prove that Mrs. Bixby lost only two of her five sons in the war, that letter was written from one broken heart to another. The grief of losing a loved one can be stifling. The great hope is the hope of

seeing our loved ones again in Heaven; and that can only occur if we and they are under the blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Please make it your priority to politely, but boldly share your witness of a changed life by Jesus Christ to everyone you love.

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.
