Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus

A mission statement is the same thing as a purpose statement in that it states why an organization exists. A purpose statement for a New Testament church never changes. It is dictated to us by the Scriptures. However, a Vision statement does change. A vision statement captures, in words, how a particular church in a particular setting at a particular time achieves its purpose or mission. We adopted our mission and vision statements in May of 2007.

<u>Mission Statement</u>: The mission of Northgate Baptist Church is to glorify God by equipping its members to be actively involved in the ministry of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
