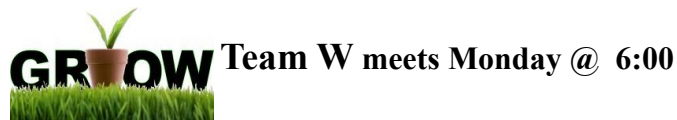
I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church!
