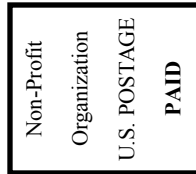

Deacon nominations at Northgate begin the first Sunday in June, (June 5). All nominations must be submitted to the church office by the second Sunday in June (June 12).

Please read 1 Timothy 3:8-13 and Acts 6:1-8 and be in prayer about deacon nominations.

- The office of Deacon is a noble and holy calling. The following requirements for serving as a Deacon are:
- The Deacon must be 21 years old and a member of the church for a year or more, and must fulfill the requirements indicated in the New Testament. (1 Timothy 3:8-13 and Acts 6:3-8).
- Live a consecrated life, bringing no reproach, either by conduct or by attitude, upon the church or the cause of Christ.
- Regularly attend and participate in the services and activities of the church.
- Must be willing to work with the Deacon body to resolve any conflicts that may arise in the church body.
- Be faithful in giving, with the tithe as the minimal objective.
- Exercise confidentiality.
- Be evangelistic and missionary in spirit and practice and deeply committed to winning the lost and discipling them in the faith.
