

We have been examining an article written by Dr. Will McRaney, Jr. entitled, "5 Ways to Overcome a Fear of Witnessing." We have seen that he listed four common fears that often inhibit our witness for Christ. Those fears are: rejection, failure, loss

of relationship and lack of knowledge. Appropriately, he also presented remedies.

Dr. McRaney wrote that the first thing we must do is to "Recognize that fear is natural, although we are seeking to live in the power of the supernatural." Another of his suggestions was, "We can recognize that fear is not from God but a tool of Satan." The suggestion we considered last week was, "Love will disperse fear." This week, we will consider his next suggestion to help us overcome fear in witnessing: "Fear should drive us to a greater dependence on God." Dr. McRaney wrote, "Remember, evangelism is about God, who chooses to use us. Reliance upon the Holy Spirit in prayer is always the position to maintain. We are never stronger than when we have bowed our spirits in dependence upon God to do what we cannot."

Sometimes we forget the incredible importance of prayer in evangelism. Salvation is God's work and prayer is our lifeline to God; therefore, prayer is vital for evangelism. Allow me to challenge you to pray for the salvation of an individual, prepare yourself to share the gospel through your testimony (by the way, if you are having a hard time with your testimony, maybe you need one) and then expect God to provide opportunities for you to share the gospel of Jesus Christ with the person for whom you have been praying. Prayer is a privilege and a very powerful tool. Without it we should be afraid to witness for Christ!

For a biblical example of prayer in evangelism, simply read Romans 10:1-3 – "Dear friends, my greatest wish and my prayer to God is for the people of Israel to be saved. ²I know they love God, but they don't understand ³what makes people acceptable to him. So they refuse to trust God, and they try to be acceptable by obeying the Law" (CEV).
