

Sunday, October 9, 2011, is World Hunger Day in the Southern Baptist Convention. I thought you might be interested in knowing these alarming world and domestic hunger statistics provided by the World Hunger Fund of the Southern Baptist Convention.

World Hunger Statistics:

- 1.02 billion people in the world do not have enough to eat. This means one sixth of humanity is undernourished. (Source: FAO, 2009).
- Hunger and malnutrition are still the number one risks to health worldwide. (Source: World Food Programme).
- Every day, almost 16,000 children die from hunger-related causes that's one child every 5 seconds. (Source: Bread for the World).
- In 2008, nearly 3 million children died before they reached their fifth birthday due directly or indirectly to hunger and malnutrition. (Source: Bread for the World).
- It is estimated that 684,000 child deaths worldwide could be prevented by increasing access to vitamin A and zinc. (Source: World Food Programme, 2007).

Domestic Hunger Statistics:

49 million Americans struggle with hunger, including 17 million children. That means 1 in 6 people do not get enough food to be healthy. (Source: Feeding America).

An estimated 35% of poor families in the U.S. are forced to choose between buying food and paying their rent or mortgage. Nearly half of all families headed by a single mother are food insecure. In our nation's cities, 1 in every 4 people in a soup kitchen line is a child.

The cost of a meal at a Southern Baptist hunger ministry averages 30 cents per meal. (NAMB Report - PDF, 2010).

World Hunger Fund Giving Statistics

100% of all contributions goes to feed hungry people. (Personnel are already in place; thus, administrative and promotional costs are borne out of other budgets.) From 2009 to 2010, giving to the World Hunger Fund dropped by nearly \$1 million (from \$6,375,000 in 2009 to \$5,410,000 in 2010). In 2010, Southern Baptist hunger ministries fed more than 5 million meals to the hungry in North America. As a result, more than 33,000 professions of faith were reported. (NAMB Report - PDF, 2010). Southern Baptists' gifts for world hunger provided for projects in more than 68 countries in 2008.

Mark Kelly, quoting Jeff Palmer, Executive Director of Baptist Global Response, wrote in Baptist Press, "Twenty percent of the donations to the World Hunger Fund are used domestically through the North American Mission Board to feed people like the victims of the Alabama and Joplin tornados. The remainder is used overseas through the International Mission Board."

Hunger is not only a world problem; it is a problem in Greenville as well. Bring canned food to Sunday School this week to help the Eastside Crisis Center meet hunger needs in our community. As we "sock it" to hunger, also bring financial offerings for the hungry to help those less fortunate than us. We will receive a love offering at the conclusion of the service this Sunday, October 9, 2011. Sunday is also Sock Day, a day to bring new men's white socks to help the homeless in our community. The homeless often only have one pair of socks and when their socks get wet or ragged, life becomes all the more miserable. There are boxes located around the church to collect socks
