

According to the January 21, 1994, edition of *Our Daily Bread*, in his book *Facing Loneliness*, J. Oswald Sanders writes, "The round of pleasure or the amassing of wealth are but vain attempts to escape from the persistent

ache...The millionaire is usually a lonely man and the comedian is often more unhappy than his audience." Sanders goes on the emphasize that being successful often fails to produce satisfaction. Then he refers to Henry Martyn, a distinguished scholar, as an example of what he is talking about. Martyn, a Cambridge University student, was honored at only 20 years of age for his achievements in mathematics. In fact, he was given the highest recognition possible in that field. And yet he felt an emptiness inside. He said that instead of finding fulfillment in his achievements, he had "only grasped a shadow." After evaluating his life's goals, Martyn sailed to India as a missionary at the age of 24. When he arrived, he prayed, "Lord, let me burn out for You." In the next 7 years that preceded his death, he translated the New Testament into three difficult Eastern languages. These notable achievements were certainly not passing "shadows."

According to the International Mission Board's website, as of October 17, 2011, Southern Baptists had 4,880 international missionaries on the field. In 2010, 360,879 people were baptized overseas, overseas church membership was 3.1 million and 29,237 new churches were planted. As of October 17, 2011, there were still 3,629 people groups in the world that have never been engaged with the gospel of Jesus Christ. According to Peoplegroups.org, a people group is defined as "the largest group through which the gospel can flow without encountering significant barriers of understanding and acceptance." John Piper defines an unengaged people group simply as "no Christians and no missionaries."

God is clearly reaching people through Northgate in our community. Pray that more people are reached in 2012. According to City-Data.com, in 2009, there were 449 congregations in Greenville County (half of them SBC) yet still 42.7% of our county's population has no religious affiliation. Let's pray for the lost in Greenville County; but even more so, let's pray for people in the world who have no access to the gospel of Jesus Christ at all. Pray for God to call out missionaries to go to them. Pray about how much God would give through us to support these mission efforts in the New Year. In 2012, I pray that Northgate Baptist Church can engage an unengaged people group if only through prayer. Let's make sure, very sure, that we are not "grasping shadows," but making an eternal difference among peoples in the world where there is no light.

The **Celebration Choir** will have a dress rehearsal for Christmas music on Saturday morning, December 10 at 9:00 in the Sanctuary.


