#### From Our Pastor

This week we are praying for North American missions. This month (and through Easter) we are giving to financially support North American missions. You received a prayer guide in your bulletin on Sunday, March 4. Please pray for these and all of our North American missionaries. North American missions consist of the United States, her territories, and Canada. In those geographical areas, there are an estimated 259 million people who do not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Of course, it is imperative that we do all we can to reach our nation and Canada with the gospel.

The North American Mission Board (NAMB) has a strategy known simply as SEND to reach people for Christ in North America. Their research reveals that the average existing Southern Baptist church will be used of God to baptize 3.4 people per 100 resident church members, while a new church plant will baptize 11.7 people per 100 resident church members. Therefore, planting new churches is a good strategy to reach the lost. In WWI, there was one church for every 430 people in America. Today that ratio is one church for every 6,194 people in America. In Canada, that ratio today is one church for every 123,971 people. NAMB's response is to plant many new churches. Different kinds of churches are needed to reach different kinds of people. The gospel never changes, but our methods of reaching people with the gospel must constantly change. NAMB has identified twenty-six strategic cities to target for church planting. While most of those cities are in the north and west, three are in the southeast – Atlanta, New Orleans and Miami.

Please pray and give during this Easter season that people might come to Christ in North America. Northgate's goal for the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering is \$4,000. The national goal is \$70 million (46% of NAMB's annual budget).

Northgate has many strategies to reach people in our corner of North America with the gospel. God is certainly using His ministry to the local schools, but He is also using His Sunday School and many other ministries. One strategy He has given to us is the invitation for Rev. Don Piper to visit Northgate on March 25. We are praying that many unsaved and unchurched people will come to this event. The gospel will be presented and people will have an opportunity to come to Christ and receive the free gift of abundant and eternal life. Pray for our North American mission efforts!

I look forward to growing with you in Sunday School and worshipping with you in church.


