FROM OUR PASTOR

Giving is a blessing. The happiest people I know are givers. It is my experience that tithing is the greatest kind of giving when it comes to finances. Tithing is an expression of faith - and God blesses faith. He blesses any expression of faith. He blesses us when we witness for Him, when we pray to Him and when we give like Him.

During the summer months, churches typically struggle to meet their budget. Northgate is already seriously behind in our budget giving for the year. I would like to request that you pray about the tithe. I would ask you to do a Bible study on the tithe. You will find that in many places where giving is the focus the power comes from the faith, not the gift. Abel's gift to the Lord was by faith (Genesis 4). The widow's gift to the Lord (through Elijah) was by faith (1 Kings 17). Elijah's gift to the Lord at Mt. Carmel was by faith (1 Kings 18). The widow's gift of the two mites was by faith (Mark 12). God blesses faith. Notice in two of those four random examples of faithful giving, the Lord used the widow (who represented the poorest of the needy) to demonstrate the greatest faith. That is not an isolated theme in Scripture, but a prominent one. God often uses the weak to demonstrate His strength. Paul stated it succinctly in 1 Corinthians 1:27 (NIV) -"But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong."

Pray about the tithe. If you are a tither, you already know the blessings. In fact, you could give a testimony about God's faithfulness. If you are not a tither, I challenge you to take the tithe test, like I did. You will never regret it! I have never met a person that regretted tithing. However, I have met many that regretted missing that blessing. The tithe test is found in Malachi 3. Malachi 3:10 (CEV) "I am the Lord All-Powerful, and I challenge you to put me to the test. Bring the entire ten percent into the storehouse, so there will be food in my house. Then I will open the windows of heaven and flood you with blessing after blessing." That is the only place in Scripture where God challenges us to test Him. God blesses the tithe because God blesses faith! Hebrews 11:6 – "Without faith it is impossible to please God."

May God bless us as we walk by faith.
