The Greek word that most often refers to the New Testament church is EKKLESIA. EKKLESIA literally means, "Called out ones." We get our English word, "ecclesiastical" from this word. It refers to a fellowship of Christians that are holy, separated, and set apart for the specific purpose of bringing glory to Jesus Christ.

The 2000 edition of the Baptist Faith and Message says the following about the local church: "A New Testament church of the Lord Jesus Christ is an autonomous local congregation of baptized believers, associated by covenant in the faith and fellowship of the gospel; observing the two ordinances of Christ, governed by His laws, exercising the gifts, rights and privileges invested in them by His Word, and seeking to extend His gospel to the ends of the earth. Each congregation operates under the Lordship of Christ through democratic processes. In such a congregation each member is responsible and accountable to Christ as Lord."

You will notice no mention of buildings or facilities in the above definitions of the church. That is because the church is people, not buildings. But of course, the people need a place to meet! This Sunday morning, we will set aside time to prayerfully and corporately dedicate recent improvements to the facilities of Northgate Baptist Church.

Also, beginning this Sunday and continuing through next Sunday, August 26, we will place a special emphasis on praying for Northgate Baptist Church. Look for the prayer guide in this Sunday's bulletin. Please invest time this week in praying for Northgate Baptist Church.


School Supplies Are Needed!


