From Our Pastor

This Sunday, October 28, is Sunday School High Attendance Day at Northgate. Are you involved in a Sunday School class? Should you be? Better yet, why should you be?

The Sunday School movement began in England in the 1780's as a way to educate children in the Bible. Through Sunday School, the emphasis of churches was to educate Christians as to their purpose and mission in life. Therefore, through the first half of the 20th century, educating the nations regarding Christ and His gospel was the priority of the church. However, in the wake of two devastating world wars, the church began to see its purpose more as a means of evangelism than education. Sunday School naturally became the evangelistic arm of the church. People often come to Christ through the work of a strong Sunday School and are more likely to grow to become active disciples of Christ through continued participation in Sunday School.

Today, churches often refer to these ministries as "small groups" where evangelism, discipleship, fellowship, ministry and worship occur. "Small groups" of like-minded Christians (and non-Christians) from the same church affiliation typically meet in private homes, restaurants or other gathering places. The result has been stronger, more educated followers of Christ. In short, "small groups" work to grow the church.

At Northgate, we have adopted the "small group" strategy to meet in our own facilities and at a convenient time for most everyone – just before corporate worship on Sunday mornings (9:30). Though we have adopted individual names for these small groups (such as Hope, Grace, Friendship, Crossties, etc.), we refer to this collective church-growth strategy as "Sunday School." We think the name "Sunday School" has a nostalgic ring to it while at the same time accurately capturing the essence of our goals.

Why should we all be involved in a Sunday School? So we can grow to become all that we can be as followers of Jesus Christ.
