From Our Pastor

We are in the season of Advent. Of course, that means our minds are fixed upon Christmas and the celebration of the incarnation of God. God gave, so we give too. Please don't forget to give to missions. There is no better gift that we can give at Christmas than to missions so the hope of the gospel might go to the ends of the earth.

In Southern Baptist life, the International Missions Board is our mission agency for world evangelization. Half of the funding for the operation of the IMB comes from the Cooperative Program which is supported through our regular budget giving. For every ten dollars that Northgate receives through our tithes to support the church budget, one dollar (10%) goes to the Cooperative Program. Those funds are forwarded to the South Carolina Baptist Convention in Columbia. In 2012, of every dollar the SCBC received from Northgate, 59 cents remained in the state and 41 cents was forwarded to the SBC Executive Committee in Nashville. Of those 41 cents, about 21 cents will be forwarded to the IMB to support international missions. Those Cooperative Program dollars provide about half of the financial needs of the IMB. The other half of those needs are provided through the annual Christmas-time Lottie Moon Offering for International Missions. In 2011, Northgate gave \$47,545 to the Cooperative Program. That means that we gave \$9,509 to International Missions through our regular tithes to the budget. In addition to that amount, we gave \$10,215 through the 2011 Lottie Moon offering. Therefore, God provided a total of \$19,724 in 2011 through His church at Northgate to reach the world for Christ!

This year, Northgate's Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for International Missions is \$8,000 (the total SBC goal is \$175,000,000). Please pray for our international missionaries (especially this week) and plan to give to the Lottie Moon Offering this Christmas that we might meet and exceed our goal. My prayer is that through the Lottie Moon Offering and our regular tithes throughout the year, God will give more than \$20,000 through His church at Northgate to reach the world for Christ in 2012!

Please pray, give and go that the gospel might be proclaimed to all peoples, tribes and nations!
