# **Thoughts from Pastor Barry**

I have been encouraged by the many people who have told me that they read through the Bible in 2013 and the many others who are reading through the Bible in 2014. Bible study to a Christian is like food to our bodies. Praise God for the many that are feasting on the satisfaction that only the Word of God can bring. "Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the man who trusts in



**Him!**" (Psalm 34:8, NKJV). Any relationship is founded upon communication; no relationship can be healthy without it. In our relationship with Christ, communication centers primarily on Bible study and prayer.

As we enter the final full month of winter, we enter a new season of prayer. Prayer to a Christian's soul is like breathing to our bodies. We will gather at least monthly for a time of corporate prayer in 2014. Watch for emails and announcements in the bulletin for dates and times for corporate prayer meetings. I encourage you to invest uninterrupted quality time every day for prayer. As part of this prayer effort, let me encourage you to fast and pray. Fasting amplifies prayer. You are in control of how long you choose to fast. Some may fast for a meal while others may fast for a day or longer. Remember, the objective is to devote that time to prayer. Please do not fast if your health prohibits it and do not tell anyone if you are fasting or not (that is between you and the Lord). Remember, we fast from food, not drink, so please drink plenty. I enjoy drinking tea, coffee or fruit juice when I fast. Remember, the New Testament never commands fasting, but it is clear from even a casual reading of the Bible that fasting is an effective and powerful spiritual discipline in a Christian's life.

E. M. Bounds (1835-1913) was an attorney, author and pastor. He wrote eleven books (nine on the subject of prayer). He wrote, "What the Church needs today is not more machinery, not new organizations, or more novel methods, but men whom the Holy Ghost can use - men of prayer, men mighty in prayer." Bounds also wrote, "The church is looking for better methods; God is looking for better men." Bounds is also quoted as saying, "God's revelation does not need the light of human genius, the polish and strength of human culture, the brilliancy of human thought, the force of human brains to adorn or enforce it; but it does demand the simplicity, the docility, humility, and faith of a child's heart."

Please join me in your private and corporate prayers for a fresh and powerful movement of the Holy Spirit in and through His church at Northgate.
