

Thoughts from Pastor Barry

May is a time for celebration. We will celebrate Senior Adult Day on Sunday, May 4. We will celebrate Mother's Day on Sunday, May 11. On Sunday, May 18, we will celebrate with our graduates and on Memorial Sunday, May 25; we will remember all of our blessings with the Lord's Supper! Without Jesus, there is nothing to celebrate!



Jesus said, "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

We best celebrate Jesus and what He did for us by emulating His servant love. Gary Inrig, in his book, A Call to Excellence, wrote the following on page 98:

"A large group of European pastors came to one of D.L. Moody's Northfield Bible Conferences in Massachusetts in the late 1800's. Following the European custom of the time, each quest put his shoes outside his room to be cleaned by the hall servants overnight. But of course, this was America and there were no hall servants. Walking the dormitory halls that night, Moody saw the shoes and determined not to embarrass his brothers. He mentioned the need to some ministerial students who were there, but met only silence or pious excuses. Moody returned to the dorm, gathered up the shoes, and alone in his room the world's only famous evangelist began to clean and polish the shoes. Only the unexpected arrival of a friend in the midst of the work revealed the secret. When the foreign visitors opened their doors the next morning, their shoes were shined. They never knew by whom. Moody told no one, but his friend told a few people, and during the rest of the conference, different men volunteered to shine the shoes in secret."

One reason D.L. Moody was among the first of the great evangelists of America is because he put himself last in importance. He was a servant leader.

As we celebrate during the month of May, let's remember that the way Jesus celebrated His last supper with His disciples was by girding Himself with a towel and washing their feet. Let's find ways to be servant leaders. Let's find ways to make much of others, more of Jesus, and less of ourselves. Let's give ourselves away in service to our great Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who gave Himself away for us!

Let's plan to give some of our time on Sunday afternoon, May 4 at 4:00 as we gather to pray for the Holy Spirit to move in and through His church at Northgate.

We are never more like Jesus than when we are giving!
