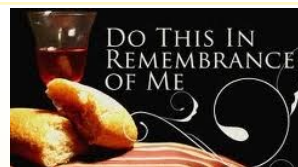

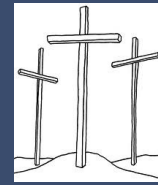

Are you resolved? I wasn't sure if I was or not, so I looked it up. The *Merriam-Webster Dictionary* defines the noun "resolved" as "fixity of purpose" or "resolute." A good working definition would be a "firm commitment". So, yes, I am resolved and so are you! We are all firmly committed to something. I am firmly committed to eating at least once every day (unless I am fasting) and I would guess that you are too! But is it possible to be resolved to something unhealthy? Absolutely.
