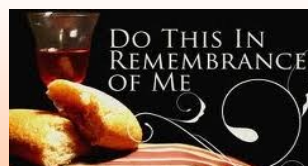


NORTHGATE BAPTIST BASKETBALL CAMP July 20-24, 2015

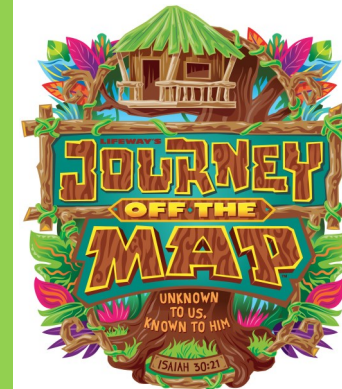
