

Thoughts from Pastor Barry

A sick man turned to his doctor, as he was preparing to leave the examination room and said, "Doctor, I am afraid to die. Tell me what lies on the other side." Very quietly the doctor said, "I don't know." "You don't know? You, a Christian man, does not know what is on the other side?"



The doctor was holding the handle of the door; on the other side of which came a sound of scratching and whining, and as he opened the door a dog sprang into the room and leaped on him with an eager show of gladness. Turning to the patient, the doctor said, "Did you notice my dog? He's never been in this room before. He didn't know what was inside. He knew nothing except that his master was here, and when the door opened he sprang in without fear."

"I know little of what is on the other side of death, but I do know one thing: I know my Master is there, and that is enough. And when the door opens, I will pass through it with gladness, but with no fear."

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen!" (Hebrews 11:1, NKJV).

Life would be frightening without faith in Jesus Christ; but because God has given us Himself through the gift of His Son and the presence of His Holy Spirit, Christians have no reason to fear death – Jesus Christ conquered it at Easter. The Apostle Paul wrote: "God's Spirit doesn't make cowards out of us. The Spirit gives us power, love, and self-control. Bon't be ashamed to speak for our Lord. God saved us and chose us to be his holy people. We did nothing to deserve this, but God planned it because he is so kind. Even before time began God planned for Christ Jesus to show kindness to us. Now Christ Jesus has come to show us the kindness of God. Christ our Savior defeated death and brought us the good news. It shines like a light and offers life that never ends." (2 Timothy 1:7-10, CEV).

I pray you have a joyous Easter season filled with the peace and confidence of our Lord Jesus Christ.
