Thoughts from Pastor Barry

The 2016 Olympic Summer Games were quite a scene. There were many stories – some bad and some good. The worst story was the false testimony given about the robbery of four American swimmers. The most notable of those four was Ryan Lochte. He said that he was robbed and that wasn't the truth. Sin will always take us where we never intended to go. The best



story also involved an American swimmer. Michael Phelps won five gold medals and one silver medal with a dominating performance in the men's swimming competition. Michael Phelps won more medals than any other athlete at the 2016 Olympics and he has won more medals (in his Olympic career) than anyone in the history of the Olympic Games.

205 nations competed in the 2016 Olympic Games and the United States absolutely dominated! The U.S.A. won forty-six gold medals (most in the games), thirty-seven silver medals (most in the games) and thirty-eight bronze medals (most in the games) for a total of 121 medals; fifty-one more medals than second-placed China. According to the Detroit Free Press, if Michigan were a nation in itself, it would have ranked 16th in the number of medals won. It is really astonishing at just how dominate the United States of America was in these games.

As stated above, China won the second most medals of the 2016 Games, but the real story is Great Britain. Great Britain is the twenty-first most populated nation in the world (China is first and the United States is third). Twenty-six of the seventy medals that China won were gold, but Great Britain won twenty-seven gold medals with a total of sixty-seven in all. When one considers the population of these three nations, those results are very impressive. 324 million people live in the United States. 1.4 billion people live in China. Sixty-five million people live in Great Britain.

How did the United States dominate the 2016 Olympics in such a staggering way? How did the Brits out-perform nations with 200 times more people? The answer is the athletes from the United States and Great Britain were better trained and better prepared.

We can't work our way to Heaven and we can't earn our salvation, but Christians are called to excellence. We are called to a higher standard. Christ is risen and He has won; therefore, in Christ, we are winners! And we live as winners. "And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ" (Colossians 3:23-24, NKJV). "Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ²looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (Hebrews 12:1-2, NKJV).

As we begin a new church year, remember that Christians aren't always the majority, but in Christ, we are always right! We are winners!
