

The Church Office will be closed for Thanksgiving on November 24 and 25. NO service or other activities will be held on Wednesday, November 23.





Thoughts from Pastor Barry

Thanksgiving is for giving thanks! We are all indebted to someone for something sometime! We are certainly indebted to God for His grace, mercy and kindness in His gift to us in Jesus Christ. We give thanks to God for His greatness!



It is easy to give thanks for those things which are easy. It is another matter to give thanks for those things which are difficult. In a speech delivered in Cambridge, England in 1910, Theodore Roosevelt said, "Of course a man has to take advantage of opportunities, but opportunities have to come. If there is not the war, you don't get the great general; if there is not the great occasion, you don't get the great statesman; if Lincoln had lived in times of peace, no one would know his name now."

British pastor, John Henry Jowett (1863-1923) wrote: "Gratitude is a vaccine, an antitoxin, and an antiseptic. This is a most searching and true diagnosis. Gratitude can be a vaccine that can prevent the invasion of a disgruntled attitude. As antitoxins prevent the disastrous effects of certain poisons and diseases, thanksgiving destroys the poison of fault-finding and grumbling. When trouble has smitten us, a spirit of thanksgiving is a soothing antiseptic."

In the Scriptures, we find many passages that remind us our need to give thanks for God's greatness!

"I will greatly praise the Lord with my mouth; yes, I will praise Him among the multitude" (Psalm 109:30).

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6-7).

"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name" (Psalm 100:4).

"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable" (Psalm 145:3).

"Praise the Lord! Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the heights! ²Praise Him, all His angels; praise Him, all His hosts! ³Praise Him, sun and moon; praise Him, all you stars of light! ⁴Praise Him, you heavens of heavens, and you waters above the heavens!"(Psalm 148:1-4).

"Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).
