Thoughts from Pastor Barry

Thanksgiving is that special time of the year that we set aside to reflect upon the grace bestowed upon us by our merciful God. As we celebrate this Thanksgiving, we especially remember our families. Our Northgate family has been blessed with many new babies in 2017!!! As you come to church for our parent/child dedication services, remember how blessed we are to have these precious families at Northgate. I encourage you to find a creative way to let these families know how thankful we are for them.



One way to give thanks would be to volunteer for preschool ministry. Be aware that our policy states that preschool volunteers must be at least eighteen years old, be church members for at least six months, and pass a confidential comprehensive background check. We value our precious preschoolers and their families at Northgate!

Another way to give thanks would be to make a generous contribution to the Northgate building fund as we prepare to begin much needed renovations. We are able to reach the current generation with the gospel because the past generations gave sacrificially to the Lord so that we could have the resources we need.
