Thoughts from Pastor Barry

Where are we with Northgate's needed renovations? That is a good question. I hope to provide some answers.

Seek. God. First. was a great success! God provided \$780,000 in commitments including \$250,000 that is already in the bank! But that is not the best part. The best part is that God has moved upon our hearts and has called us to a powerful season of prayer. I have never seen Northgate pray like she is praying now.

We are experiencing a prayer revival! In February, we met for cottage prayer meetings with more than 100 of us involved. Then, on the weekend of March 16-18, we prayed for 48 continuous hours in the sanctuary! 160 of us, in thirty minute increments, prayed around the clock – twice!! "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (James 5:16, NKJV). I know we believe that verse because we are living it! We are praying because prayer changes things.

The Seek. God. First. Construction Team met during Holy Week and discussed the path forward. Easter Sunday was also First Fruits Sunday at Northgate. We began giving our offerings to meet our commitments. God instantly blessed us! The Construction Team has developed an agenda for the beginning of renovation:

- The pricing of the renovation is being reviewed and confirmed or updated.
- We have requested proposals from banks for a construction loan (if needed). Of course, the church will not assume any debt without first receiving church approval.
- We will request proposals from qualified general contractors well suited for church renovations. These companies have been identified.
- We are evaluating:
 - a) Updated construction pricing.
 - b) The giving results of the Seek. God. First. emphasis.
 - c) General contractors.
 - d) A construction loan proposal.

Upon completion of these items of business, the Construction Team will present a recommendation to the congregation as soon as possible. The Construction Team hopes to provide this in very short order and will ask for a special business meeting to share information and seek approval to begin work.

It is the desire and intention of the Construction Team to begin renovation quickly. However, there are many moving parts. Following a particular order of steps is necessary if we are to be wise stewards of what God has provided. For instance, it would be great to replace the roof immediately, and that would seem reasonable. However, the damaged and decaying wood in the soffits must be replaced (followed by the drip-edge) prior to the shingles being installed. There is simply an order of construction, and it behooves us to follow it.

Thank the Lord for providing an excellent team of leaders who know these things! It will take careful and considerate planning to be the best stewards of the time and resources The Lord has graciously provided for His church at Northgate.




Sunday - May 6
