# **Thoughts from Pastor Barry**

November is to autumn what May is to spring. Both months are important, refreshing and memorable. Two of my favorite days fall in November: Veterans Day and Thanksgiving Day. In my view, both of those holidays provide opportunities to give thanks.

I recently visited a military museum in Brevard, NC, where I met two combat veterans from the Vietnam War. As I often do, I thanked them for their service to our nation and reminded them that I can do what I do because they did what they did. I am very mindful of the fact that I have the wonderful blessing to preach the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ without the fear of persecution. We all have the privilege to worship openly in the United States without fear of government harassment or persecution. In fact, if soldiers or law enforcement entered the sanctuary on any given Sunday, it would be to join us in our worship not to stop our worship!

Sometimes I think we forget just how blessed we are. It is good that Veterans Day and Thanksgiving fall within the same month. They go together like peanut butter and jelly!! Let me encourage you to go out of your way to thank veterans this month for their service to our nation. By the way, I have noticed that veterans (especially combat veterans) are quick to point out the difference between Memorial Day and Veterans Day. 
#### **GOOD NEWS CLUB**
