# **Thoughts from Pastor Barry**

Happy New Year! When we think of the New Year, we think of resolutions, right? Well, my motto for 2019 is: Forget resolutions... *Just do it*!

Life is short, friends. We can't relive the minutes that have passed. One of my grandmother's favorite "stories" on TV was Days of Our Lives. The show's catchy intro contained one singular truth: "Like sand through the hourglass, so are the days of our lives." Time is fleeting, and I encourage you to embrace something challenging in the New Year. Maybe you've never:

- Truly tithed you know, given the first 10% of your gross income to the Lord through His church.
- Read all the way through the Bible in one year.
- Spent the first fifteen minutes of every morning in prayer and meditation getting your daily marching orders from our Lord Jesus.
- Led anyone to faith in Jesus. Maybe you have never tried.
- Prayed aloud.

I hope you will decide to take on a challenge, commit it to the Lord, and just do it in 2019. One of the keys to success in life is allowing the Lord to live His life through us. In those times when you feel inadequate or insecure, ask God to be:


