Thoughts from our Pastor

April showers bring May flowers and Mayflowers bring...Pilgrims! Many of us remember that childhood joke. One thing we know for certain is that springtime brings change. The Greek philosopher, Heraclitus, said, "The only constant in life is change." How true!

Sir Edwin Landseer was one of Britain's most famous painters in the 19th century. Once, while visiting a family in an old mansion in Scotland, he saw a servant accidentally spill a pitcher of water on one of the walls, leaving a large stain. While the family was out for the day, Landseer used charcoal to transform that ugly stain into a beautiful painting of a waterfall surrounded by trees and animals. He used his skill to make something beautiful out of what seemed to be a hopeless mess.

God works much the same way in our lives. He can take what might seem to be a mistake or misfortune and turn it into something beautiful and worthy. God's grace provides the strength needed to meet any challenge and overcome any perceived weakness. Indeed, the challenge of change must be viewed through the lens of Scripture:

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal. (2 Corinthians 4:16-18).

When we find our confidence in Christ, we can approach any change with a sense of hope and excitement. Even when our circumstances change, our constant is Christ! As He tells us through the words of the Apostle Paul, "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy 1:7). So, change is nothing to fear; rather it is something to welcome and embrace because we know Jesus Christ is Lord!

We have seen many changes at Northgate already in 2019. As a church we've been praying for God to move and it is evident that He is. The renovations have brought beautiful, much needed change to our facilities, making them more accommodating for us and our community. 


