

Sometimes summertime at church can be like that experience. Summer is the busiest time in the life of the church. It is prime time for preschool, children and youth ministry activities. More lives are changed through events and camps and activities during the summer than any other time in the church year. At times, ministry can seem overwhelming and taxing. Yet at the same time, it is an exhilaratingly joyous time! Tina Jimmerson, our Interim Minister of Children and their Families, reminds us of the "4-14" window.

According to the International Bible Society:

83% of all Christians make commitments to Jesus Christ between the ages of 4 and 14.

LifeWay Research reports:

Vacation Bible School consistently accounts for roughly 25% of baptisms in Southern Baptist Churches. Twenty-five percent of all people reached by any given church are reached through Vacation Bible School.

Vacation Bible School is near the end of summer. Between now and then, we have a packed calendar of activities! Basketball Camp is June 6-10, Youth Camp is June 20-25 and Centri-Kid (children's camp) is July 11-15. Again, VBS is July 24-28. Before, between and following these dates there will be other activities for our preschoolers, children and youth.

June 17-18 and July 22-23 are key dates for all of the above. These are the dates for our next two prayer vigils. Please plan to call the church office and sign up to be a prayer warrior for this summer of ministry. Prayer is powerful and effective. The Holy Spirit through the power of prayer is the engine of the church. "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." (James 5:16, NKJV).
