A Message from Dennis Page, Worship Leader

The information for this article was gleaned from a variety of sources including "Then Sings My Soul, Favorite Hymn Stories."

1903 was a big year for Thomas Chisholm. It was that year he was ordained and given a congregation of his own in Scottsville, Kentucky. It was also that same year, he married the love of his life, Catherine Vandervere. Just six years later in 1909, health issues forced Thomas to leave his congregation. In the years that followed, and as medical debts increased, Thomas alternated between bouts of illness and gainful employment in which he did everything from journalism to insurance sales to evangelistic work.

Many people would have become bitter with God during a time of health and financial crisis, yet Thomas became quite the opposite. The third chapter of Lamentations became precious to him: "His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness" (verses 22-23). Thomas' positive outlook on life never shifted, and in 1923, he took up pen and paper and wrote his most famous poem: "Great Is Thy Faithfulness."

He sent the poem to Reverend William Runyan, a musician at Moody Bible Institute where it moved Runyan so much that he quickly took to praying that God would reveal a tune worthy of the lyrics. Once Runyan composed the tune, "Great Is Thy Faithfulness" a hymn was born.

It was an instant favorite amongst Moody Bible Institute staff and students, and quickly became the college's unofficial hymn. It might have remained within those walls except a young man named Billy Graham heard it and began using it in his crusades in the 1950's. What began as a simple poem from a simple man was now reaching the ears of millions.
