God has been moving in amazing ways through His church at Northgate!



In 2021, we concluded a successful three-year capital campaign (Seek. God. First.) to raise funds for much needed renovations for the facilities at Northgate. Upon conclusion of the campaign, we discovered that God had provided 119% of the finances pledged during the campaign to achieve these renovation goals!

The four-phase renovation project included the renovation of the fellowship hall, restrooms, preschool and children's areas, the sanctuary, a new HVAC system, education areas and more. We are nearing completion of phase three of this plan. Thus far, God has provided the funds, skill and labor to accomplish all of this work debt free.

The remaining items for the final phase of this plan (phase four) include: renovating the parking lots, the gym, the kitchen, a shade structure for the playground, new signage and a new roof for the kitchen.

The Renovations Committee does not believe that God is leading us to begin a new capital campaign to finish this work or to take on debt to finish this final phase of renovation work. However, we strongly believe that God wants His church to be aware of the remaining work and the associated costs of completing it.

A breakdown of the estimated costs for the completion of phase four are:

Parking Lots -	\$120,00
Gym -	50,000
Kitchen -	40,000
Playground Shade -	25,000
Signage -	25,000
Kitchen Roof -	40.000

Total estimated costs for the completion of phase four - \$300,000

Please pray about these remaining needs and how God may meet them through you and your family. The Renovations Fund remains open and active. In fact, every month offerings are donated to this fund and it has grown to the point that has allowed us to continue renovations since the completion of the Seek. God. First. campaign. It is truly a blessing to be a part of what God is doing through His church at Northgate!! Don't miss this opportunity to give to this exciting work!

Thoughts on the passing of Queen Elizabeth II

"Pray for me ... that God may give me wisdom and strength to carry out the solemn promises I shall be making, and that I may faithfully serve Him and you, all the days of my life."

- Queen Elizabeth II, on her first Christmas broadcast, December 25th, 1952.

The funeral was a remarkable, God honoring service. There was, of course, the mesmerizing pageantry, but one couldn't help but see, and even feel, that something else was also at work. In the end, she was appropriately honored, as was her Maker.

By all accounts Queen Elizabeth was a godly woman with a deep-seated relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. Over the decades, while many around her, including her own family, experienced moral failings, she remained above reproach.

In 1955, the BBC's broadcast of Billy Graham's appearance in Scotland was viewed by chance by Prince Philip and the Queen. That set-in motion a chain of events that led to her inviting Graham to come to Buckingham Palace for a meeting. While Graham was in London, he met with Queen Elizabeth on at least three more occasions. Thus, was born a special friendship. According to the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, there were at least 12 documented times he met with the Queen.

In 2012, 60 years after her first Christmas broadcast, she concluded her Christmas broadcast by praying for her people and inviting a practical, servant-hearted response to Jesus Christ's message of love: "This is the time of year when we remember that God sent his only son "to serve, not to be served." He restored love and service to the center of our lives in the person of Jesus Christ." Alternate Ending 1: It seems that Queen Elizabeth's prayer from the start of her reign has been answered".

Alternate Ending 2: It is my prayer this Christmas Day that His example and teaching will continue to bring people together to give the best of themselves in the service of others." The carol, "In the Bleak Midwinter" ends by asking a question of all of us who know the Christmas story, of how God gave himself to us in humble service:

What can I give him, poor as I am?

If I were a shepherd, I would bring a lamb;

If I were a wise man, I would do my part...

'Yet what I can I give him - give my heart'.

One commentator shared that "throughout her long life, Christ's example and teaching have been seen acted out in the dutiful and faithful life of our servant-hearted Queen. It seems that her prayer from the start of her reign has been answered."
