A Message from Dennis Page, Worship Leader

What's the big deal about congregational worship? In last month's Gatepost, we looked at the first five of "Ten Reasons for Congregational Worship" as found in the worship planner edition of "Songs for Praise and Worship". This month we'll look the other five. As you will see, congregational worship is a big deal! Here they are:

6. To testify of Christ, and to exalt Him

"But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself" (John 12:32). As we exalt Christ, then others will see Him, and be drawn to His character of mercy, grace, and love.

7. To guicken our awareness of the final outcome of history

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). "That at the name of Jesus every knee shall bow, in heaven and on earth and under the Earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:10–11)

As we bow in worship to God, we are just practicing for the day when all the Earth will bow before Him.

8. To defeat the enemy

"As they begin to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab... and they were defeated" (2 Chronicles 20:22). People who are praising God and who love the Word will bind the enemy (found in Psalm 149:6–9)

9. To establish a spiritual throne for the Lord in our midst

"Yet You are enthroned as the Holy One; You are the praise of Israel" (Psalm 22:3) People who are praising God are stewards of Christ's authority. His throne is upon our praise. He rules as we worship.

10. To help to unify the Church "They will come and shout for joy on the heights of Zion; they will rejoice in the bounty of the Lord..." (Jeremiah 31:12). Singing in the heights of God's presence will cause a flowing together and unity of hearts.

Congregational worship is a big deal! As I suggested last month, I hope you'll read this over again, meditate on these scriptures, and bring a fresh mindset (or should I say heart-set), to our next worship service. God will be honored and you will be blessed.
